Jenni and her amazing team cooked a special football celebration lunch on Thursday. We enjoyed waving our multi-nation flags and the football cookies for pudding!

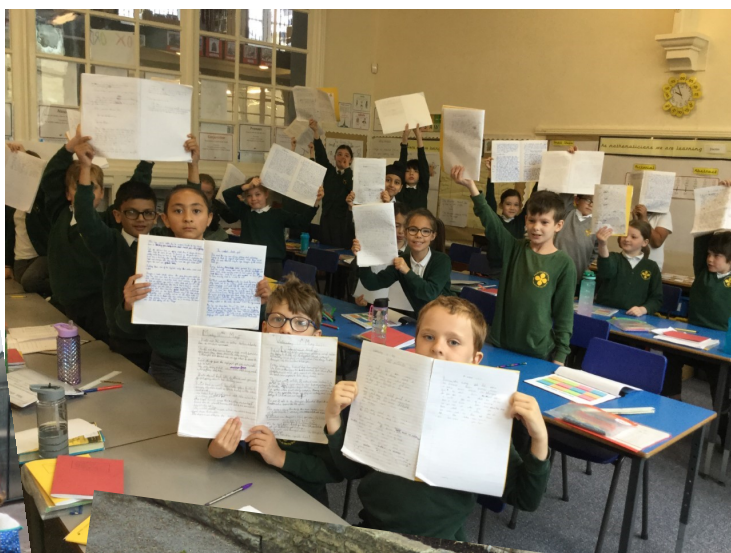


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## This week at Parish...
