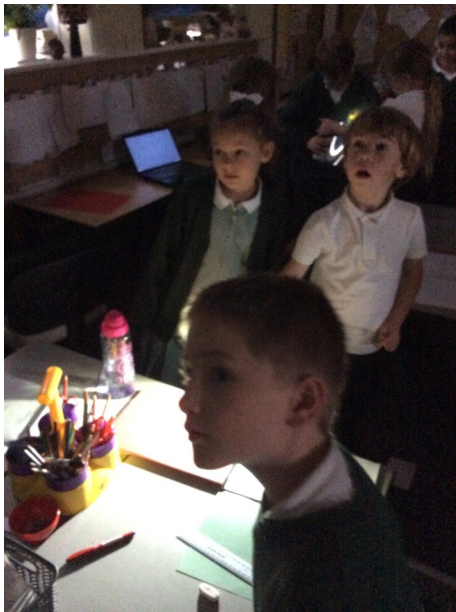


Thank you so much to all those who have donated towards Children in Need this year. So far the school has raised a fantastic £258

## Skipton Step Into Action Christmas Elves Appeal

Skipton Step Into Action is a community voluntary group providing support for people (of all ages) in the local area. We believe that every child should experience the magic of Christmas and, as such, we are coordinating a scheme to provide gifts for children in the local area.

Last year we provided gifts for 119 children in Skipton and the surrounding villages, made possible by the generosity of our community.

Whilst some of the world has returned to normal, parents on low incomes are still struggling and Christmas can add to these financial worries. We estimate that in the local area alone, there will be at least 150 children benefiting from our appeal this year.

### How does it work?

Families can request a specific gift up to the value of £20 for their child or children. These are then added to a gift list for people to buy and drop off with us. We aim to add to this gift with a variety of extras, including a selection box, a knitted hat or scarf, a toy or game, a soft toy, a book, and anything else we are given. All of the gifts are then wrapped by our team of volunteers, and delivered by Skipton Fire Service.
