## COVID REMINDER

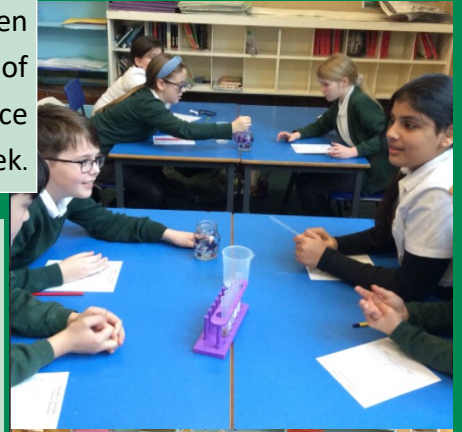
