The Good Shepherd Centre have appealed for help from local residents to send desperately needed items to the Ukrainian refugees crossing the border into Poland. They have arranged lorries to deliver the donations.

### Particular items they are looking for:

- Basic medical supplies: paracetamol, ibuprofen, antiseptic cream, bandages, sterile dressings
- For babies: nappies, dried powdered milk, wet wipes
- Toiletries: toothpaste, toothbrushes, shower gel, deodorant, sanitary products, shampoo
- Thermals, socks, hats/gloves for all ages
- Warm blankets
- Torches

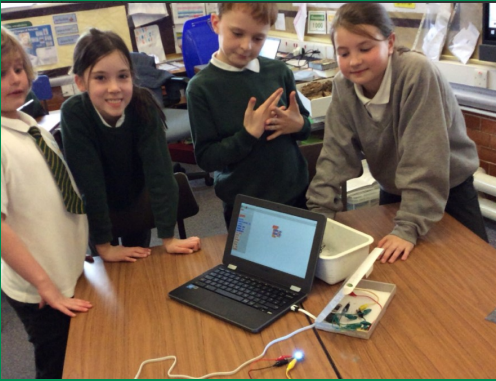

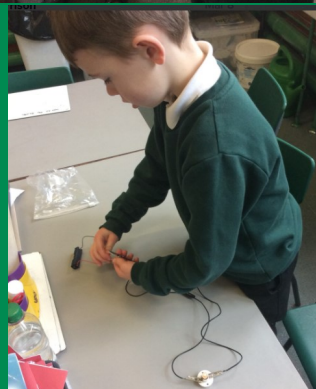
## Around school this week
