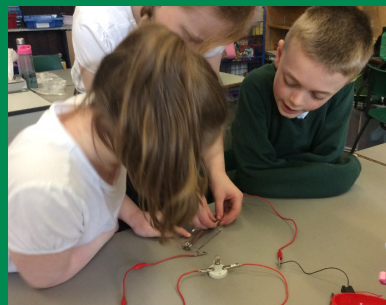
Around school this week



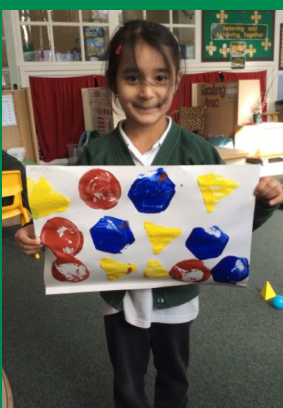
For Red Nose Day the children had great fun running egg and spoon relay races in their classes.
