Proceeds from the raffle will be split between the PTA and charities in support of Ukraine, as requested by pupils on the School Council



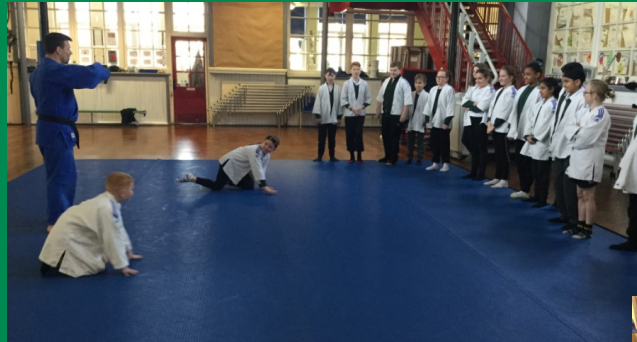

This week all the classes enjoyed a fun judo taster session. The children should have brought home a leaflet giving details of classes run in Skipton if they are interested in taking this further.



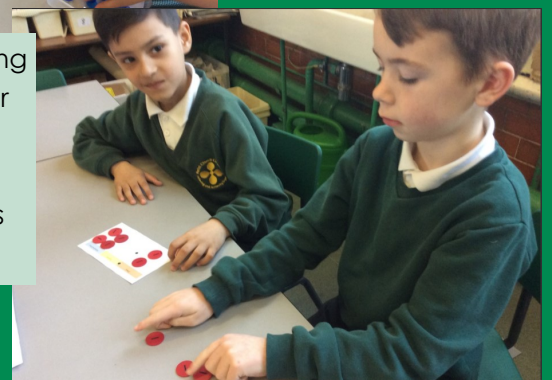
In science Cheviot class have been exploring chemical reactions and irreversible changes.
