End of school collection arrangements

Dear Parents and Carers

Firstly, I would like to thank you for your support and cooperation over the past two years regarding the changes we have had to put in place because of Covid-19.

Now that the restrictions have been removed, we are very keen to open up school to everyone, whilst maintaining the safeguarding of the pupils.


We would like to trial some new end of school arrangements that we hope will be an improvement. These will begin on Monday 4th April. The drop off arrangements in the morning remain unchanged.

Collection Area B.

Please access the school grounds using the front gate. The children will exit school via the side entrance onto the playground where they will be handed over

Collection Area A

Please access the school grounds using the side gate. The children will be handed over at the green fence at the entrance to the EYFS playground



Area A

Suffolk and Cotswold classes will be first to be handed over at 3.05, followed by Swaledale and Teeswater classes at 3.10

Area B

Dalesbred and Dorset Downs classes will be first at 3.10, followed by Oxford, Cheviot and Herdwick classes at 3.15.

There will be no sibling groups, all children will be in their own classes.



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We politely request that the adult collecting the child, waits until the child is handed over to them by the member of staff and **not call them over**. This enables staff to account for every child and means that we can safeguard the pupils at the end of the day.

We would like to remind you that dogs are **not allowed** onto the school grounds and this does include those being carried.

The gates will be opened as soon as the PE lesson is finished at 3.00pm and close at 3.25pm to allow after-school clubs to start. If, for whatever reason, your child is late to be collected, then they will be brought into school and should be collected from the main reception.

We are also hoping to reintroduce bun sales and other events on the playground. When this is the case, then arrangements regarding gates, will be adapted as necessary.
