Well done to all the children who took part in our Commonwealth Games themed Sports Day this week. They all tried their best and really supported their classmates



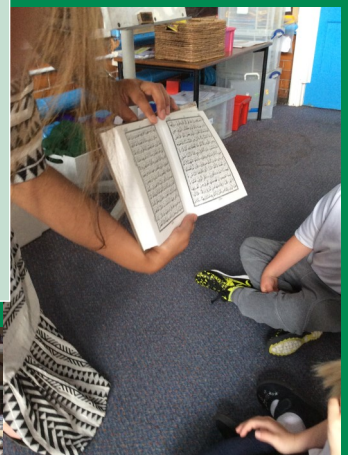
