Each month we pick a topic which families say can be difficult to navigate on their own.

We put together all our resources, advice, and learning to offer a short informal presentation.

We have up to 10 spaces available at each session and would offer additional sessions if oversubscribed.

Other family members and carers who look after your child are also welcome to attend.

After the presentation we then have a hot drink and biscuits and chat through any specific issues you might be struggling with (if you feel comfortable doing so).

If we think you would benefit from further support, we can support you in accessing this.

Our workshops are available to all families in Craven with a child SEND, you can access them at any time, and you don't need a referral to our team.


We now offer our workshops over Microsoft teams for anyone who would prefer this format.

If you would like to access a workshop but the time doesn't work for you, or if you think there is a health-related issue that isn't covered by our workshops, **please get in touch!**




### **A World Book Day Fact File researched and written by J-T (Year 4)**

World Book Day changes lives through a love of books and shared reading and was originally started in April 1985 as a way to help children fall in love with books and reading. Charities are donated as a way to also help children and families who wouldn't normally be able to buy these books.

In 1995, UNESCO decided that The World Book and Copyright Day would be celebrated on the 23rd of April, as the date is the anniversary of the death of William Shakespeare and Garcilaso de la Vega and the birth and death of several other writers.

Originally, Vicente Clavel Andrés, a Valencian book writer, suggested that the day should be on a day that honoured the author Miguel de Cervantes. This would be either his birthday, October 7th, or his death date, April 23rd.
